PEARL SENSITONE PREMIUM WOOD SINARES

From £419 Two updated popular maple snares plus a rare 15" diameter African mahogany addition to the relaunched SensiTone range

maple shells

e reviewed three of Pearl's 13 revamped SensiTone Classic and Premium snares in the July issue. Those all had metal shells and now we reveal the only three wood shellers, which all boast the Premium specification with new ARL arched bridge lugs. Two have maple shells – a 14"x5" and a 14"x6½" – and the third has a rather more unusual 15"x5" shell made from African mahogany.

Build

Let's start with the atypical 15" diameter shell which consists of four plies of African mahogany just 5mm thick, strengthened top and bottom with reinforcing glue rings of four-ply maple. The bearing edges are cut at 45° rising to the outermost mahogany ply where there is an immaculate edge, slightly sanded over for a silky smooth peak. It's gorgeously done to a top-class standard while the outer rich red-brown mahogany is rubbed to a smooth natural finish. With the contrasting chrome and brass metal work this is one handsome drum.

The two Satin Maple finish drums are also lookers, though maybe not quite as show-stopping. They have typical Pearl Superior Shell Technology (SSL) six-ply American maple shells, still pretty thin at 5.4mm. Inner and outer plies are laid horizontally with no inner obstructing re-rings.

As we saw with the Premium metal drums, the new ARL Arch-Tube lugs replace the previous, less striking square bridge lugs. They have a three-part construction incorporating two separate brass tubes held in place by a chromed, minimal-shell-contact, cast arch. Since the two tubes are separated in the middle they are essentially self-aligning, reducing the possibility of cross-threading.

Also new is the impressive SR-150 strainer/throw-off which Pearl calls



Hands On

The really interesting drum here is the 15" mahogany which is reminiscent of the old WFL drums from the 1940s and 1950s. And with the overlapped scarf joints and re-rings it looks like a vintage drum on the inside too, more so than other big manufacturers' recent forays into revisiting vintage styles.

Back in the early days - from the 1920s on - 15" snares were not uncommon. Whoever would have thought that an inch would make such a difference? But just as many have found a 13" snare behaves guite

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differently from a 14", so too does a 15". Pearl describes it as a 'baritone' snare drum, which seems reasonable. It has a big, rich, slooshy backbeat, not so much fat as deep and foreboding. Even at high tuning it has a dark timbre. That extra inch width gives it a bit more ring too, especially at lower tunings where the drum sounds big and echoey. Loosen the snares a little and let the drum breathe. Perfect for those Herlin Riley or Stanton Moore-style New Orleans loose press rolls. This is a different, more

suited to being all-round workhorses. Maple is brighter and a little broader toned possibly, more cavernous sounding, with good sustain. You can't go much wrong with a well-constructed 14"x5" maple snare and this will be the more versatile drum for most. The 61/2" is both fatter and clonkier a bigger sound, but more ponderous. Even at higher tunings it retains that reassuring warm depth helped by the
